Henry Stern, an educator and environmental attorney, is the senior policy advisor to California State Senator Fran Pavley. A sixth-generation Californian, his passion for public service grew from his family roots, whose diverse history includes ranching, entertainment, and a commitment to helping youth fulfill their potential.

Henry helped Senator Pavley achieve some of the most important legislative victories in recent history. Together, they advanced bipartisan measures to balance the budget, cut climate pollution, tackle California's water crisis, address teacher shortages, ensure safer communities, block unregulated fracking, and stop runaway production in the film industry. Most recently, Henry spearheaded efforts to clean up the SoCal Gas leak in Porter Ranch and crafted the landmark climate legislation, SB 32.

A graduate of Harvard University and UC Berkeley Law, Henry has diverse experience in education, the environment, juvenile justice and infrastructure. Prior to serving the 27th District, he served as counsel to Congressman Henry Waxman, advised clean energy businesses, civil rights groups and universities as an environmental attorney, taught civics, advocated for juvenile justice, and founded a tech incubator.

Henry also teaches law at UCLA, volunteers at the Boys & Girls Club, and is a member of the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy, the Jewish Federation, and the Truman National Security Project.

Henry received the most votes in the Nov. 8, 2016 general election for the 27th State Senate District seat.
